

Questions and Answers

Q: What is the usual format?

A: We aim to start the session at 8:00pm, so we ask that you arrive from 7:45pm to allow time to get settled and make yourself comfortable. Every evening is a bit different, but generally the chairperson for the evening will say a few words to welcome everyone and introduce the speaker. Then for the next hour and a half, the speaker takes over to lead the evening. The chairperson then thanks the speaker, gives a very short inspirational thought for the evening and gives notice of forthcoming events. The raffle is then drawn and the chairperson closes the evening, usually around 9.45pm.

Q: How much will it cost me?

A: Evenings of clairvoyance are £6 (unless tickets are booked in advance, in which case they are £5). Other standard events are £5. Special events may be held from time to time, and ticket prices will be advertised.

Q: How much do raffle tickets cost?

A: We charge £1 for a strip of 5 tickets. There are always at least 3 prizes on offer from a choice of 4 or more depending on the event. When stated, the proceeds of the raffle will be donated to any of the selected charities supported by the KSTG.

Q: Is there a minimum age for anyone wishing to attend?

A: Officially no! Everyone is different but, we would advise that most events are not suitable for people under the age of 14.

Q: Will I have to participate?

A: We believe that the most enjoyable way of learning is through experience and so generally, our workshops and circle evenings involve everyone's participation. During evenings of clairvoyance, if the medium comes to you, you are invited to interact with them. However please be assured that if there is anything you feel uncomfortable or nervous about taking part in, just let one of the team know. You will be welcome to observe.

Q: Can I arrive late or leave early?

A: To avoid disturbing the speaker and fellow participants we like to keep comings and goings to a minimum. Therefore if you arrive late you may find the door closed. However, if you knock gently, a member of the team will generally let you in. Once the door is closed we prefer that people remain in the room. However, if there is an emergency or you need to leave, please let a member of the team know.

Q: Will I be embarrassed by anything?

A: The group meets in an atmosphere of mutual respect and support. If you feel uncomfortable with anything which is being said or done, please say so. Occasionally participants may become emotional and tearful – don't worry, this is a perfectly natural and acceptable reaction. Tissues, drinking water and support will be provided.

Q: Why do I need to switch off my mobile phone?

A: Mobile phones work on wavelengths and electro-magnetic energy. Mediumship, healing and many of the other subjects we cover work using energy vibrations and so we like to "keep the frequency clear" and free from interference. Switching to silent doesn't clear the air so that's why we ask you to switch off completely.

Q: Will there be an opportunity to talk to the medium/speaker afterwards?

A: The speaker/s may be around for a few minutes at the end of the session, at their discretion.
